El Hierro is a magic island, and *Pozo de la Salud*, a prodigious spring with curative properties, adds to the magic, as well as the fascinating underwater formations seen just off the rugged coastline.

The unusual sight of windmills, a reminder of its farming past, can be found throughout **Fuerteventura**, known as the *Granary* of the Canary Islands and surrounded by no less than 150 beaches.
